
Crofton 4-H members had a blast learning about GPS, and how satellites work! They even had a chance to attempt to build satellite towers of their own.

Directions

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water.
- 2. Over medium-high heat cook bacon for 3-4 minutes.
- 3. Add the rest of the ingredients and bring them to a boil.
- 4. Reduce heat to simmer and allow to cook until the peas are tender, about 30 minutes.
