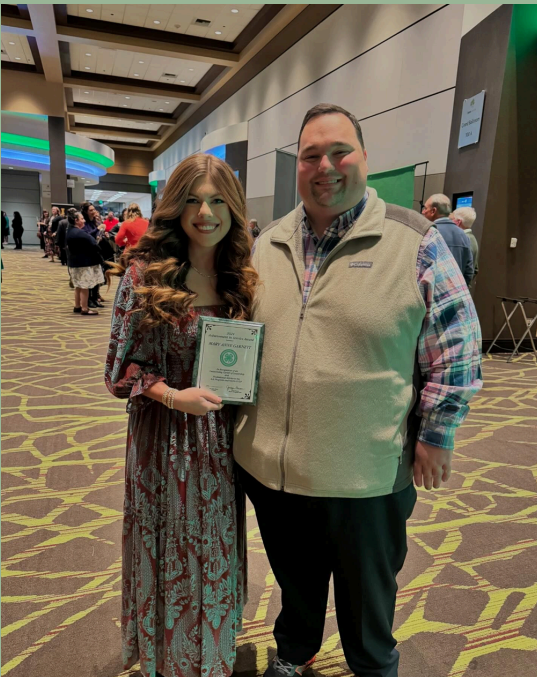


Cooking Club
