PACHEK

Each group was given a scenario that they had to try to overcome. One situation was finding another resource to power the making of maple syrup besides fuel and the other was what could leftover pistachio shells be used for.





Fruit & Yogurt Frozen Treat

Ingredients:

- 1 cup blueberries
- 1 cup strawberries
- ¾ cup fat free yogurt

Directions:

- Rinse 1 cup of blueberries in cold tap water, drain and place in a self-sealing sandwich bag.
- Rinse 1 cup of strawberries in cold tap water and drain. Cut the cap off each strawberry, chop into medium-size pieces and place in a separate sandwich bag.
- Squeeze out excess air as you tightly seal each sandwich bag.
- Gently mash each bag until the berries are broken down.
- Evenly divide the mashed blueberries among four single serve freezer pop molds or paper cups and freeze for 30 minutes (or until firm).
- Evenly divide yogurt on top of frozen blueberries and insert a wooden craft stick. Freeze for 30 minutes (or until firm).
- Evenly divide the strawberries on top of the frozen yogurt and freeze again for 30 minutes (or until firm).
